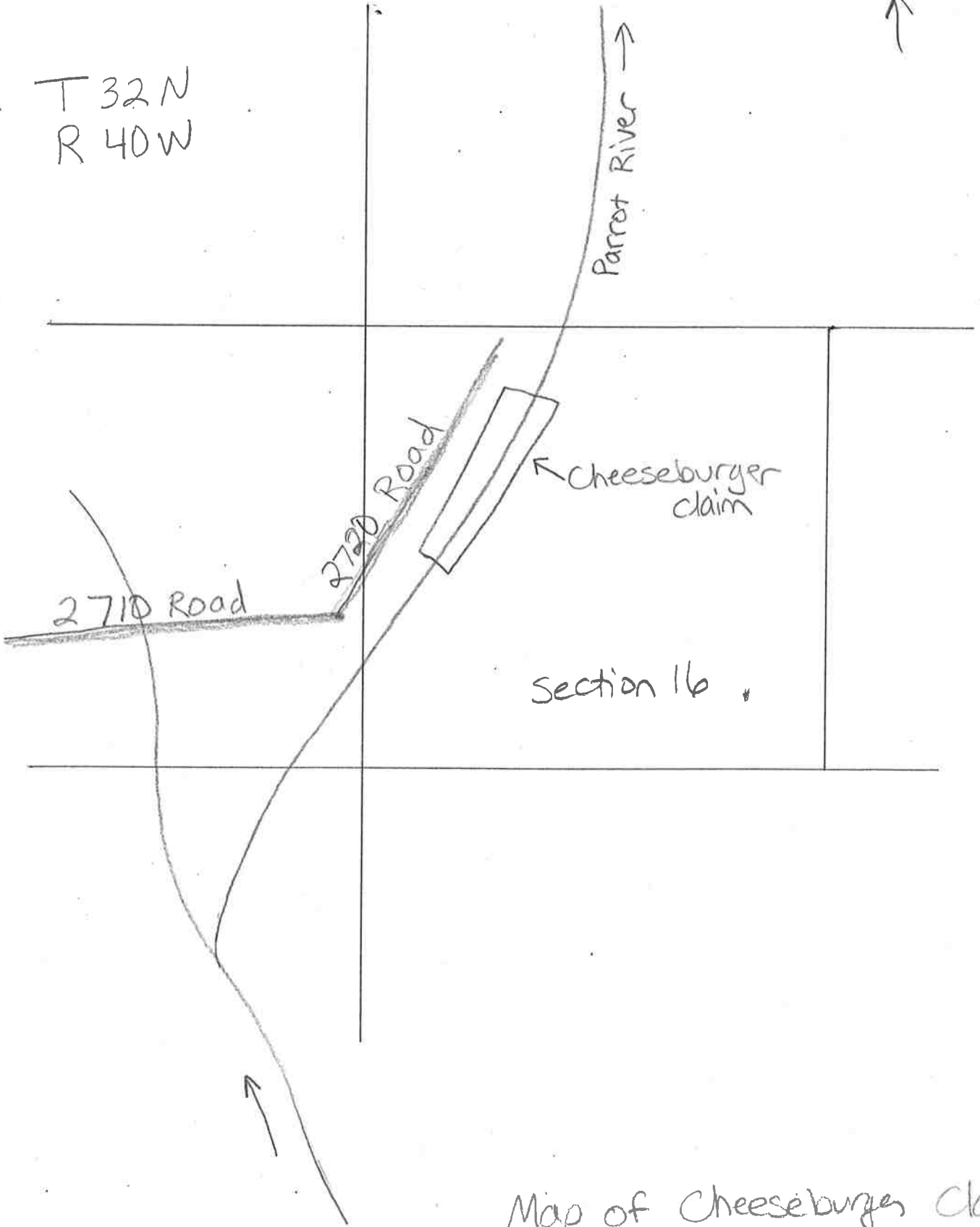

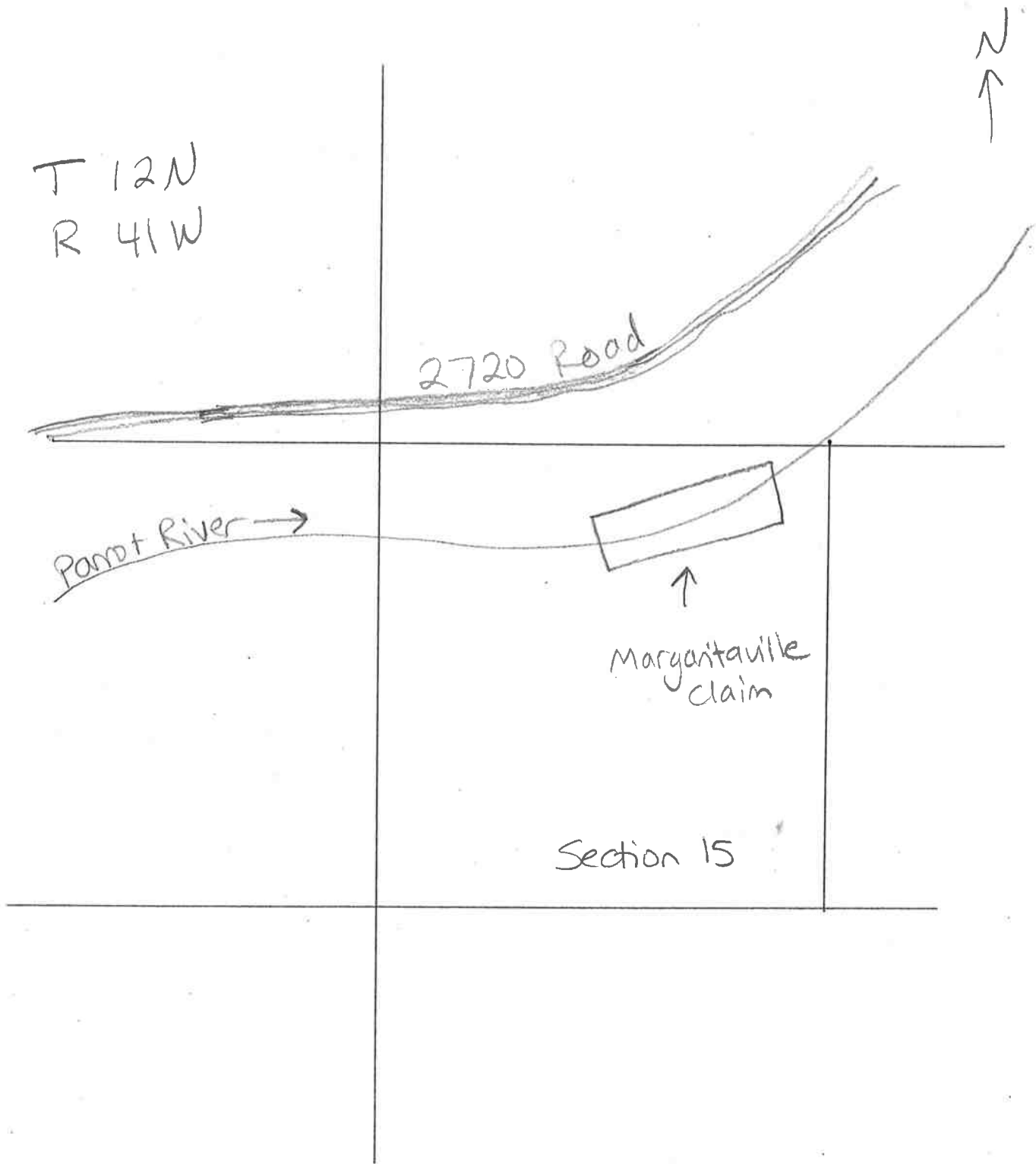

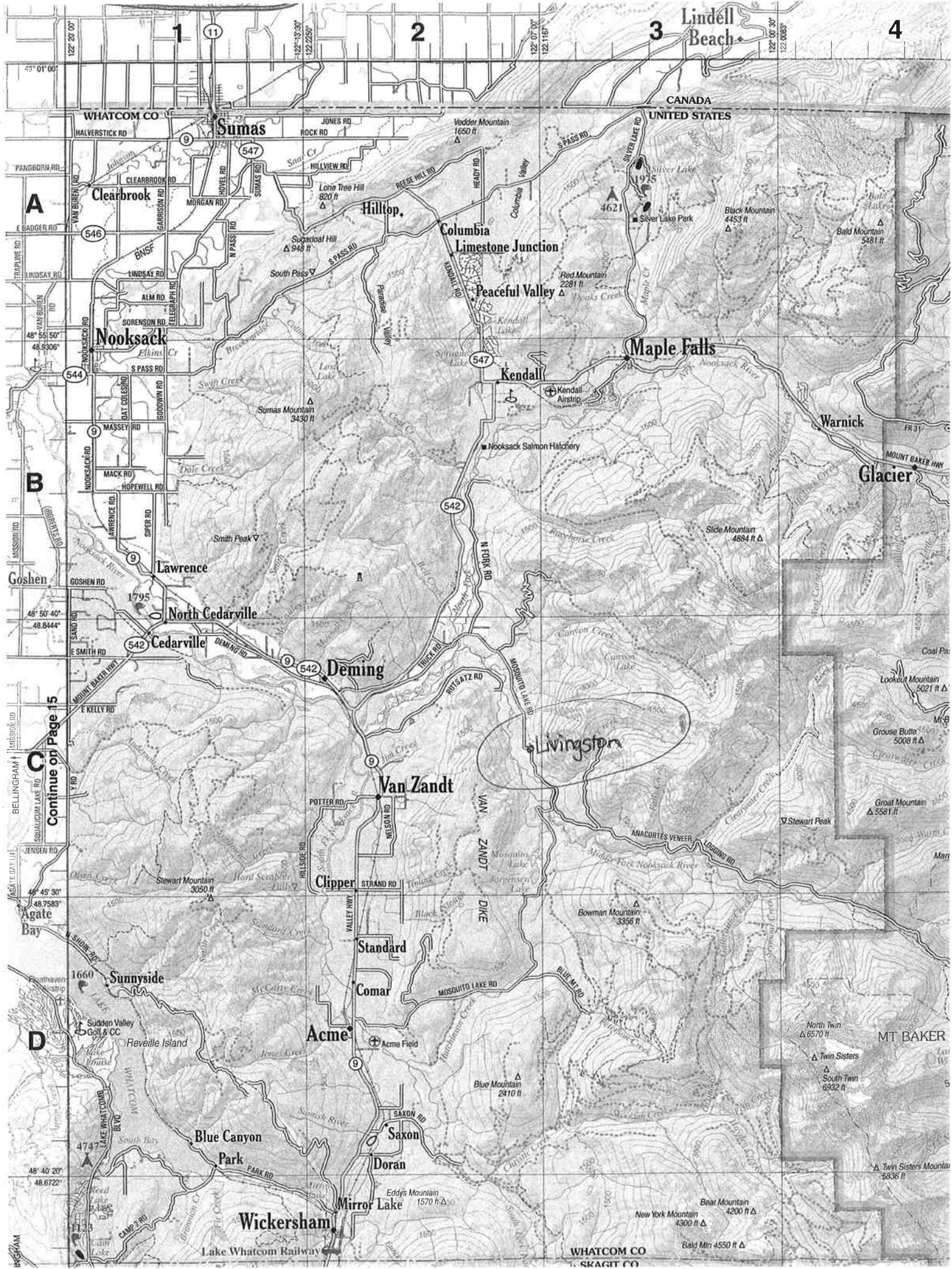
Map of Cheeseburger Claim
